To secure the cable after routing, use soft Velcro tie wraps instead of plastic zip ties, which can inadvertently crush the cable and increase signal attenuation. Any run through open wall cavities or high-traffic areas should be protected using flexible low-voltage conduit. Running fiber internally involves extending this high-speed link from the service entry point to a centralized location, such as a dedicated media closet or network rack. This DIY effort is undertaken to maximize performance, improve aesthetics, or relocate the Optical Network Terminal (ONT) to a.
