

How to use a dual-port multimode fiber optic transceiver

Step-by-Step Usage

Check Compatibility: Ensure the transceiver matches your network device (switch, router, or media converter) and supports multimode fiber. Verify the wavelength (e.g., 850 nm) and speed (1G, 10G, 40G, 100G) are compatible with the other end of the link .

Insert the Transceiver: Hot-plug the SFP or QSFP module into the device port. The module should click into place securely. Ensure the device is powered on and supports the module type .

Prepare Fiber Cables: Use duplex multimode fiber patch cords with LC connectors. One strand will carry TX signals, and the other RX. The front panel of the transceiver is usually labeled TX and RX .

Connect TX to RX: Cross-connect the fibers: the TX port of the transceiver on one device connects to the RX port of the transceiver on the other device, and vice versa. This ensures proper bidirectional communication .

Clean Connectors: Always clean fiber connectors before insertion to prevent signal loss or errors. Use fiber cleaning tools or wipes designed for optical connectors .
