Optional Commands To check PoE on a specific interface: `CodeCopydisplay poe interface gigabitethernet 1/0/0` To forcibly supply power if negotiation fails: `CodeCoppoe force-power` To enable or disable PoE on an interface: `CodeCopy[HUAWEI-GigabitEthernet1/0/0]poe enable[HUAWEI-GigabitEthernet1/0/0]undo poe enable` By default, PoE is enabled on supported interfaces, with a maximum of 30 W per port for standard PoE+ devices. This helps ensure powered devices like IP phones, access points, and cameras receive stable power and allows troubleshooting of PoE-related issues.
