Distribution Box Wiring

- Live (L) Wires:** Connect incoming live wires to the line terminals of the circuit breakers. For parallel connections, ensure each phase's cables are connected to the corresponding breaker terminals (R-R, S-S, T-T) to maintain phase integrity.
- Neutral (N) Wire:** For single-pole breakers, the neutral bypasses the breaker and connects directly to the neutral busbar. For double-pole breakers, both live and neutral are controlled simultaneously.
- Protective Earth (PE):** Connect the PE wire to the ground busbar. In parallel systems, ensure all PE connections are secure and properly labeled to prevent safety hazards.
