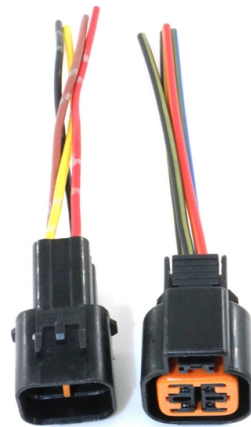


Install charging stations near the power distribution box

Key Considerations for Placement

- Proximity to the Panel:** The closer the charger is to your main electrical panel, the lower the installation cost due to reduced conduit and heavy-gauge wiring requirements. Ideally, keep the charger within 25 feet of the panel to minimize material and labor costs ().
- Height and Accessibility:** Mount the charger 36–48 inches from the floor for comfortable access. Ensure the cable can reach the vehicle's charging port without creating tripping hazards, typically 18–25 feet in length ().
- Indoor vs. Outdoor:** Indoor installations (garage) protect the charger from weather and extend cable life. Outdoor installations require NEMA 3R or higher-rated enclosures and may need concrete pads for pedestal-mounted units ().
- Electrical Requirements**
 - Circuit Sizing:** EV chargers are continuous loads. Size the circuit at 125% of the charger's rated amperage. For example, a 40A Level 2 charger requires a 50A breaker and appropriately sized conductors, usually 6 AWG copper wire for a 48A charger ().
 - Dedicated Circuit:** Install a dedicated 240V circuit for Level 2 chargers. Hardwiring is preferred for efficiency and safety, though a NEMA 14-50 outlet can be used if code-compliant ().
 - Panel Capacity:** Check your panel's available slots and total amperage. Homes with 200A service typically accommodate a Level 2 charger without upgrades, while 100A or older panels may require service upgrades or load management systems ().
 - Grounding and Protection:** Ensure proper grounding and GFCI protection per NEC Article 625.54. Outdoor or wet locations require additional protection ().
