

Installation height of emergency lighting distribution box



Overview

Height: commonly 7-10 ft AFF; a typical wall mounted emergency light height is 7-9 ft to keep heads above sightlines and throw light forward. This guide walks through wall, ceiling, end/flag, and recessed mounting—plus spacing, aiming, and on-site emergency lighting installation tips—so you avoid shadows.
