Edges of the box should be flush with the wall, and contact surfaces should be coated with anti-corrosion paint if embedded in masonry. Proper alignment ensures safe operation, prevents stress on fasteners, and maintains aesthetic quality. Height and Accessibility Indoor wall-mounted boxes should be installed at 1.4–1.7 meters (4.5–5.5 feet) from the floor to the center of operation, making them easily reachable without bending or stretching. Outdoor boxes should be at least 3 feet above ground to avoid water and dirt exposure. For ground-mounted boxes, raising them 2–4 inches above the floor prevents moisture damage. Consistency in height is important in large installations, such as malls or industrial plants, to facilitate maintenance. Maintain strain relief for conductors to prevent pulling at terminals during service. Arrange heavier components lower in the box to improve the center of gravity and reduce stress on fasteners.
