

Installation of Pole Cable Management Frame



AI Overview

Pole cable management frames are mounted to wooden poles using screws and straps, allowing secure attachment and rotation for cable handling. Installation Steps

Select the Pole Location: Choose a wooden pole that provides sufficient clearance for the frame and allows easy access for cable routing. Ensure the pole is stable and free from damage.

Attach the Pole Bracket: Mount the pole bracket to the wooden pole using the included screws. The bracket provides a proper distance between the pole and the frame, ensuring space for cable management.

Mount the Main Frame: Position the main part of the frame onto the pole bracket. If the frame has positioning pins, align them with the recesses on the bracket and slide the frame into place. Tighten any captive screws to secure the frame.

Secure the Closure: Place the splice closure into the main part of the frame and fasten it using the included strap. Ensure the closure is stable and does not move during cable handling.

Cable Routing: Route the cables neatly along the frame. The rotating feature of the main part allows you to wind or adjust cables without dismounting the frame.
