Ensure that each cabinet door is also connected to the PE row with a copper braided wire. Proper grounding prevents electrical hazards and ensures compliance with safety standards .Wiring and Circuit ProtectionInside the box, organize wiring neatly and use the correct wire gauge for each circuit. Install circuit breakers, fuses, and surge protectors for each branch circuit to prevent overloads and short circuits. When connecting busbars, ensure correct phase alignment and avoid contact with other devices or the box shell. Perform visual inspections and multimeter tests before powering on to verify conne...
