

Installation steps for drop fiber optic cables

Installing a fiber optic drop cable involves careful planning, proper cable selection, routing, termination, and testing to ensure reliable FTTH connectivity.

- Planning and Site Survey** Begin with a site survey to map the route from the distribution point (FAT box or flower pod) to the subscriber's premises. Identify obstacles such as utility poles, HVAC ducts, steel beams, or water crossings. Ensure compliance with local permits, building codes, and safety regulations. Leave 25–40% extra conduit space for future expansion and maintenance.
- Selecting Materials and Equipment** Choose the appropriate drop cable type based on environment and fiber count: G.657.A2 bend-insensitive fiber is recommended for indoor corners and tight routing. Figure-8 self-supporting cables with PE jackets and steel or FRP strength members are ideal for aerial installations. Round or flat drop cables with UV-resistant LSZH jackets are suitable for outdoor/indoor transitions. Prepare tools such as fusion splicers, cable clamps, tension-monitoring pullers, and safety equipment.
- Routing the Cable** Depending on the installation method:
 - Aerial installation:** String the cable between poles using a winch or pulling mechanism, securing it with clamps while avoiding excessive tension or sagging.
 - Underground installation:** Pull or blow the cable through micro-ducts or conduits. Directional drilling may be used to cross roads or waterways.
 - Pushable fiber:** Can be manually or mechanically pushed from the distribution point to the premises, minimizing labor and disruption.
- Termination and Splicing** At the subscriber end, terminate the drop cable at an External Termination Box (ETB) or Optical Network Terminal (ONT). Use fusion splicing for low-loss connections, or pre-terminated connectors to simplify installation. Ensure proper slack loops inside the FAT tray to accommodate temperature-induced fiber movement.
