

Key procedures for laying optical cables in ducts



AI Overview

Optical cables in ducts are installed using careful preparation, duct conditioning, and either pulling or blowing methods to minimize stress and ensure long-term reliability.

Pre-Installation Preparation Before laying cables, it is essential to survey and prepare the route. This includes identifying manholes, cable loops, and duct sections, cleaning pipelines, checking for toxic gases, and ensuring all necessary materials, machinery, and personnel are ready. Cable drums should be conditioned, and the installation team must follow a security plan and signaling system appropriate to the environment. Duct Conditioning Ducts must be inspected and cleaned to remove debris or obstructions. For longer or complex routes, tests may be conducted to ensure accessibility and smooth cable passage. Proper duct material, typically high-quality HDPE, is recommended to reduce friction and mechanical stress on the cable.

Cable Handling Optical fiber cables are sensitive to excessive pulling, bending, and crushing. Use figure-eight coiling for unreeled cable to prevent kinking, and avoid continuous coiling beyond 30 meters. Barricades or traffic cones should be used when working in public areas to prevent accidents.

Installation Methods

Pulling Method Traditional pulling involves manually or mechanically drawing the cable through the duct. Maximum pulling tension must not exceed the cable's rated limit, and the cable should be supported to avoid sharp bends or stress points. Lubricants may be applied to reduce friction in long or curved ducts.

Blowing/Jetting Method Blowing uses high-speed compressed air combined with a mechanical pushing force to move the cable through the duct. This method reduces friction, minimizes stress, and allows longer continuous lengths, especially i...
