Connects to tertiary distribution boxes or directly to equipment in some cases. Designed for safety and aesthetic appeal, often with powder-coated exteriors and rainproof tops for outdoor use. Forms part of a three-tiered protection system, ensuring that each circuit or device has dedicated protection through RCDs and breakers. Functional Hierarchy The distribution system typically follows a three-level hierarchy: Primary Distribution Box: Main panel connected to the transformer, distributing 0.4 kV power to secondary boxes.
