Handling and Physical Care

Connector Cleaning: Contaminated LC or MPO/MTP connectors are the leading cause of link failures. Use fiber cleaning pens or lint-free wipes with isopropyl alcohol to clean both module and patch cable connectors before insertion.

Dust and ESD Protection: Store modules in anti-static bags and avoid touching optical interfaces. Electrostatic discharge can damage the internal DSP and laser components.

Thermal and Power Management

Monitor Temperature: 1.6T modules generate more heat due to high-speed PAM4 signaling and DSP processing. Ensure adequate airflow in the switch or server chassis and monitor module temperature via Digital Diagnostic Monitoring (DDM).

Power Budget Compliance: Typical QSFP28 modules consume 3.5–4.5 W, but 1.6T modules may require higher power. Verify that the host port can supply sufficient power to maintain stable operation.

Signal Integrity and Diagnostics

Check FEC Alignment: Forward Error Correction (FEC) must be correctly configured to prevent CRC errors and link flapping. Misalignment can cause intermittent failures.

Use DDM Features: Monitor real-time voltage, laser bias, transmit/receive power, and temperature to detect early signs of degradation.

Cable and Fiber Verification: Ensure fiber type (single-mode or multimode) matches module specifications. High-speed PAM4 lanes in 1.6T modules are sensitive to insertion loss and reflections.
