

Metal Cable Tray Installation Methods

Step 1: Planning and Inspection Before installation, review the approved drawings and specifications to confirm the layout, dimensions, and mounting height of the cable tray system. Materials include metal cable trays (ladder or perforated type), couplers/splice plates, mounting brackets (wall arms or ceiling struts), threaded rods, anchor bolts, and grounding straps. Ensure all trays and accessories are inspected for damage before installation.

Step 3: Install Supports Determine the support spacing, typically every 1.5–2 meters, or as specified by the manufacturer. Establish a level line for the bottom of the tray using a laser or nylon string. Install supports such as wall brackets, ceiling struts, or threaded rods, ensuring they are securely anchored and aligned. For bends, place supports no more than 600 mm from the bend outputs.

Step 4: Assemble and Mount the Tray Position the tray sections along the marked path. Use splice plates to connect sections, avoiding mid-gap or directly above supports; ideally, place them at one-quarter of the gap length. Ensure the tray is level and properly aligned. For bends and tees, maintain the minimum bending radius specified for the largest cable to prevent damage.

Step 5: Cable Installation and Grounding Install cables according to NEC fill limits (power cables $\leq 40\%$, control cables $\leq 50\%$) and maintain separation between high-power and low-power circuits to prevent EMI. Metallic trays can serve as grou...
