- Multicast and Broadcast Control:** Manages broadcast domains and optimizes multicast traffic.
- IP Address Translation and DHCP Services:** Can provide Layer 3 services such as IP routing and DHCP for connected devices.

Deployment and Design Aggregation switches are typically deployed in pairs for redundancy, often using Multi-Chassis Link Aggregation (MCLAG) to ensure failover and high availability. They are not intended for direct connection to end-user devices; instead, they aggregate traffic from access switches and connect to the core layer. In large campuses or data centers, multiple aggregation blocks can be deployed to scale across buildings or floors.
