- QSFP+ / QSFP28:** Used for 40G and 100G Ethernet, often with MTP/MPO connectors.
- XFP:** Older 10G transceiver standard compatible with multimode fiber.

Fiber Type Compatibility

- OM1 (62.5/125 μm):** Works with LED sources, supports 1G Ethernet up to 275 m and 10G up to 33 m.
- OM2 (50/125 μm):** LED-based, supports 1G up to 550 m and 10G up to 82 m.
- OM3 / OM4 (50/125 μm):** Laser-optimized for VCSELs, supports 10G up to 300-550 m, 40G/100G up to 100-150 m.
- OM5 (50/125 μm):** Wideband multimode fiber for short-wavelength division multiplexing (SWDM), supporting multi-wavelength 40G and 100G links.
