FOA standards, such as FOA-1 through FOA-4, provide guidance on testing insertion loss, optical power, and OTDR measurements, bridging the gap between manufacturer-focused standards and field applications. FOA standards are voluntary but widely recognized for ensuring proper installation and testing practices.
4. **European Regulatory Standards** In Europe, fiber optic components must comply with CE marking, RoHS, and REACH regulations. CE marking ensures conformity with EU directives, while RoHS restricts hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment. REACH requires ongoing material...
