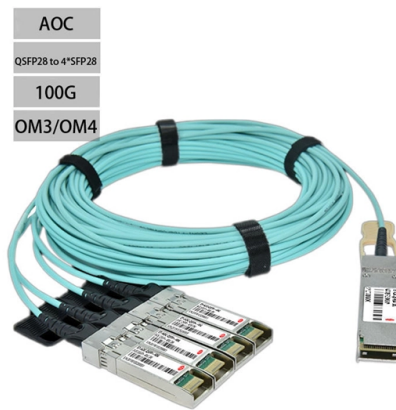


Network Communication Cable Trays

- Wire Mesh or Basket Tray:** Constructed from welded steel wires, lightweight and flexible, making it ideal for low-voltage, data, and fiber optic cables. It allows easy cutting and shaping on-site and promotes ventilation.
- Channel Tray:** U-shaped, compact, and cost-effective, suitable for light cable loads and short runs in confined spaces.

Materials and Construction Cable trays are typically made from steel, aluminum, stainless steel, or fiberglass, chosen based on environmental conditions and load requirements. Steel trays may be pre-galvanized or hot-dip galvanized for corrosion resistance, while aluminum offers a high strength-to-weight ratio and excellent corrosion resistance. Wire mesh trays often use welded steel mesh, sometimes with recycled content, providing structural integrity while remaining lightweight.
