

Network patch panel bracket installation

Attach Adapter Brackets: Align the bracket screw holes with the rack holes. For 23-inch racks, use the specific accessory kit (e.g., NCS1K-23-KIT). For ETSI racks, use Z-shaped adapter brackets and the ETSI kit.

Secure Brackets: Use a screwdriver to tighten screws to the recommended torque (e.g., 4.65 N-m or 41 lbs-in) to ensure stability.

Mount the Patch Panel: Slide the panel into the brackets and secure it with screws or cage nuts as provided.

Installation Steps for Wall-Mounted Panels

Select Mounting Location: Choose a solid surface like a wood backboard or drywall with studs for secure anchoring.

Attach Bracket to Wall: Use screws and anchors appropriate for the wall type. Ensure the bracket is level and firmly secured.

Mount the Patch Panel: Place the panel onto the bracket and fasten it. For shielded panels, bond the panel to ground to maintain proper EMI/ESD protection.

Cable Preparation and Termination

Run Ethernet Cables: Pull Cat5e/Cat6 cables to the back of the patch panel.

Strip and Prepare Wires: Strip the cable jacket and untwist pairs, keeping twists close to the termination point to reduce interference.
