Fiber optic cables are often laid along railway lines and major roads, facilitating connectivity between cities and industrial areas. Key domestic routes include Pyongyang to Odaejin, Hamhung, Rajin-Songpa, and Nampo, although the exact layout and capacity remain largely opaque due to the country's secrecy.
