- Splice Trays:** Protect fiber splices and maintain proper bend radius to prevent signal degradation.
- Cable Management Accessories:** Rings, guides, and holders maintain neat fiber routing and protect fibers from stress.
- Flanges:** Serve as the interface plates for fiber connectors, allowing secure and standardized termination of fibers within the patch panel or ODF.
