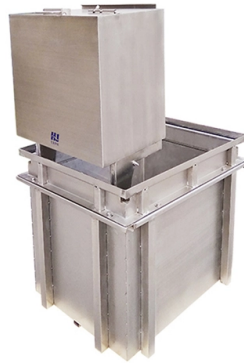

If either Tx or Rx is in the -30 dBm or lower range that's usually indicative of there being no actual signal received and the transceiver is reporting. While dBm is the actual power level represented in milliwatts, dB (decibel) is the difference between the powers. If the optical input power is P1 (dBm) and the optical output power is P2 (dBm), the power loss is $P1 - P2$ dB.
