

Requirements for placing pigtail cloth in the computer room



AI Overview

Pigtail cloth (fiber optic pigtails) must be installed with careful handling, proper routing, and environmental controls to protect both personnel and sensitive equipment.

Handling and Safety When placing pigtail cloth in a computer room, personnel safety is paramount. Avoid stepping on cables or equipment, and ensure that ladders, scaffolding, and other tools are in good condition before use. Use pulling grips to isolate connectors from tensile loads, and never exceed the cable's bend radius or tension limits, as this can damage the fiber and degrade performance. Keep hands free of tools when ascending or descending ladders, and clean up any spilled lubricants to prevent slips.

Environmental Considerations Computer rooms are sensitive environments where dust, particles, and gases can damage hardware. Maintain airborne particulate levels within recommended limits (Class 100,000 per FED-STD-209E) and minimize exposure to ultrafine particles and corrosive gases such as chlorine compounds, ammonia, and sulfur oxides. Avoid placing pigtails in areas where airflow could carry contaminants directly onto connectors or equipment.

Routing and Placement Pigtail cloth should be routed carefully to avoid interference with pedestrian traffic and other equipment. Use cable management systems such as trays, racks, or conduits to secure pigtails and prevent accidental dislodging. Ensure that cables are not coiled excessively; if coiling is necessary, use a figure-eight pattern with loops of 5-8 feet to relieve pressure and prevent kinking. Avoid placing cables under tension around hardware, and maintain clear paths for personnel to move safely.
