- Residual Current Devices (RCDs):** Protect against earth faults and leakage currents, often applied at both secondary and tertiary levels.
- Overcurrent Protection:** Fuses or circuit breakers safeguard against short circuits and overloads. Modern systems may use IDMT (Inverse Definite Minimum Time) relays with selectable characteristics (NI, VI, EI, LTI, RI, HR, FR) for precise coordination with the network.
- High-Set and Low-Set Stages:** Allow selective tripping to isolate faults quickly while minimizing disruption to unaffected circuits.
- Self-Supervision and Fail-Safe Trip:** Advanced relays monitor internal faults and provide automatic tripping if critical failures occur, ensuring safety even during relay malfunctions.

- Enclosures:** Powder-coated or weatherproof exteriors with inner and outer doors for safety and accessibility.
