Include protection devices such as MCBs, RCDs, RCBOs, fuses, and surge protectors, with each circuit having its own protection. Follow neat cable management practices and secure grounding. Prepare a wiring diagram showing feeders, protective devices, busbars, terminal numbering, and conductor sizes for clarity and compliance.

Safety Measures Ensure power is completely cut off before installation and verify with a tester. Wear personal protective equipment: insulating gloves, safety glasses, and slip-resistant shoes. Use calibrated tools such as screwdrivers, wire strippers, multimeters, and insulation testers.
