

Stripping of 6-core optical cable



AI Overview

Proper stripping and fixing of a 6-core optical cable requires careful layer-by-layer preparation, precise cleaving, and secure splicing to ensure optimal signal transmission. Cleaning: Use alcohol wipes to remove debris and dust from the stripped fiber ends.

Cleaving and Inspection Use a fiber optic cleaver to create a clean, perpendicular end face on each fiber. Adjust the cleaver according to the fiber diameter and desired cleave length. Inspect each cleaved fiber with a microscope or VFL to ensure there are no cracks, nicks, or irregularities.

Fixing or Splicing the Cable Trim Damaged Ends: If the cable is cut or frayed, trim the ends with a fiber optic cutter to remove damaged sections.

Insert into Connectors: Place the stripped fiber ends into metal terminals or inline connectors and crimp securely using a fiber optic crimper.

Splicing: For permanent repairs, use fusion splicing or mechanical splicing. Align fibers carefully, splice one by one, and place them in protective tubes. Heat or secure the tube as required.

Organize and Secure: Pre-reel the fibers into a storage tray, fix both ends with nylon ties (not too tight), and cut off any excess fiber.

Final Steps Test the connection using an optical power meter or VFL to ensure proper signal transmission. Seal the splice...
