- Cross-Connect and Termination Hardware** Insulation displacement connectors (IDC) for copper cabling. Fiber optic patch panels and termination hardware. Work Area Outlets (WAOs) and cross-connect fields ().
- Installation and Verification Services** Labor for rack assembly, cable installation, and pathway setup. Third-party field verification for compliance with TIA/EIA-568 and TIA/EIA-569 standards (). Rectification of any faults identified during verification.
- Documentation and Compliance** Construction checklists for design review...
