The ground resistance between all system parts should be less than 0.1 Ohm to ensure safe operation. Grounding wires should be securely attached to the mounting plate and connected to the factory or building ground. Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. On the US market, a 5.26 mm 2 (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm 2 must be used.
