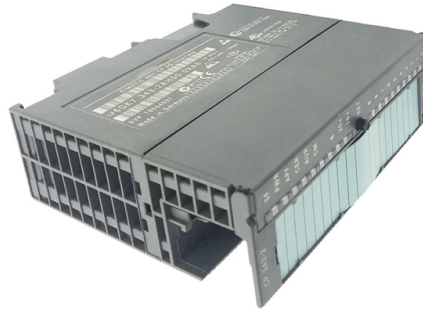

5. Avoid incorrect cable selection The cables must meet technical specifications for voltage and current capacity. Using undersized or inappropriate cables can lead to excessive heat, voltage drops, and potential failure.
6. Do not neglect environmental protection For outdoor installations, rainproof measures must be applied to incoming and outgoing lines. Exposing cables to moisture without protection can cause insulation breakdown and short circuits.
7. Maintain proper creepage and clearance distances The electrical separation and creepage distances between incoming and outgoing units must meet regulatory requirements to prevent arcing and electrical f...
