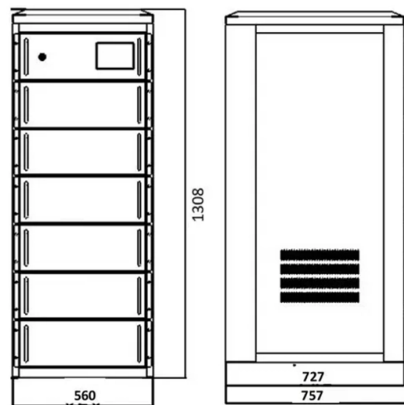

Removing and reinserting the module allows the system to reset the receiver and transmitter, clearing these transient faults.

Mechanical and Environmental Factors Proper insertion ensures that the module locks securely into the port, engaging the internal spring mechanism. Misalignment or incomplete insertion can prevent the module from functioning. Re-plugging also helps verify that the fiber jumper is fully seated, and that dust caps or contaminants are removed, improving optical signal quality.
