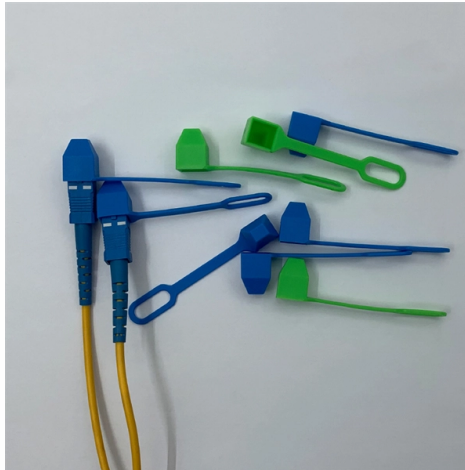

Handling: Avoid bending, pulling, or squeezing the jumpers excessively. Maintain proper bending radius and avoid tangling to prevent signal loss or damage. Labeling: Properly label each jumper to identify the source and destination, which simplifies maintenance and troubleshooting.
