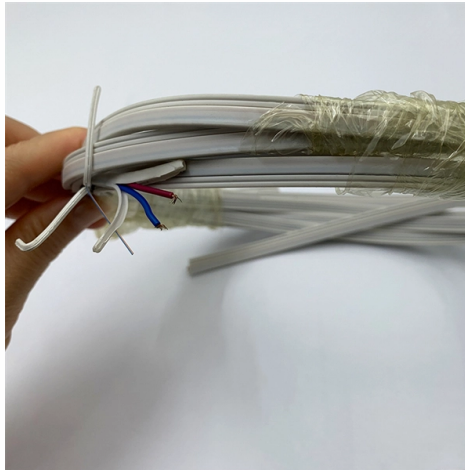

This method is simpler and preferred for straight shafts with minimal bending. Flexible or snaked installation: Cables are allowed to form gentle curves or loops, which can reduce stress on the cable during thermal expansion or contraction. Key safety measures include: Fail-safe mechanisms to prevent cable free-fall in case of rope or grip failure. Proper calculation of cable weight and tensile strength to avoid rupture.
