They provide long-term durability against UV radiation, moisture, and mechanical stress, commonly used in feeder and distribution cables exposed to the elements.

LDPE (Low-Density Polyethylene) LDPE sheaths offer greater flexibility than HDPE, which can be advantageous for installations requiring tight bends or frequent handling. While more flexible, LDPE is less resistant to harsh outdoor conditions and is typically used in shorter runs or indoor/outdoor transitional applications.

OFNP (Optical Fiber Nonconductive Plenum) OFNP, also known as plenum-rated jackets, are made from fluoropolymer materials like FEP or PTFE. They are engineered for air-handling spaces such as ceilings and raised floors, where fire propagation must be minimized. OFNP...
