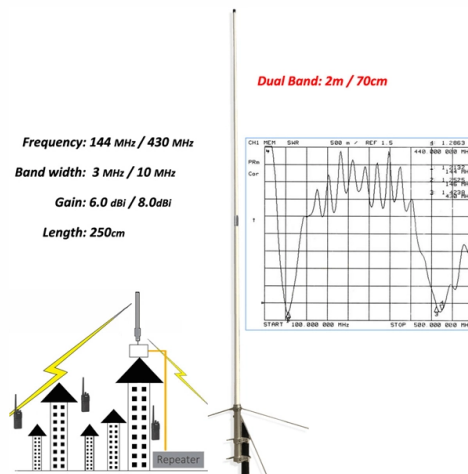

Facilitate quick reconfiguration of network connections without disturbing permanent splices or backbone cables. Bridge optical devices in data centers, FTTH setups, and local area networks. Support different transmission modes: single-mode for long-distance links and multimode for short-distance, high-speed connections. Accommodate various connector types like LC, SC, FC, ST, and MPO depending on equipment and density requirements.
