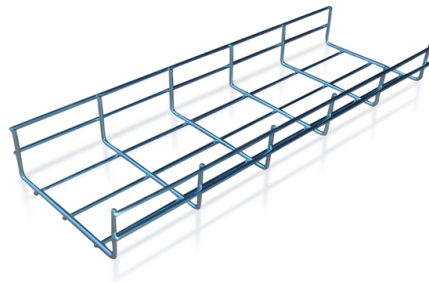


What does FC mean in the distribution box wiring

A fused connection unit (FCU) — commonly called a fused spur — is a wiring accessory that provides a permanent, fused connection to a fixed electrical appliance. Designers use short name (abbreviation) for the electrical components and equipment in electrical drawings that describes about components or equipment to electrician.
