- OM2:** Core 50 microns, better bandwidth and reach (~260 ft at 10 Gbps).
- OM3:** Optimized for laser sources (VCSELs), supports 10 Gbps up to 1000 ft.
- OM4:** Higher bandwidth than OM3, supports 10 Gbps up to 1300 ft and 40/100 Gbps over shorter distances.
- OM5:** Newest standard, supports short wavelength division multiplexing (SWDM) for multiple laser colors, enabling up to 200–400 Gbps over short distances.
