- Redundancy and Resiliency:** Often deployed in pairs with redundant power supplies and fans to maintain high availability.

Deployment Considerations Aggregation switches are typically higher-performance devices than access switches, with faster switching speeds and fewer but more robust interfaces. They are essential in large enterprise networks, data centers, and campus networks where traffic from hundreds of users or devices must be efficiently managed. In smaller networks, the aggregation layer may be omitted to reduce costs, but for networks exceeding 200 users, deploying aggregation switch...
