Ampacity and Fill: Tray fill must be calculated based on conductor size, insulation type, and tray type. For power cables, fill should not exceed 40% of the tray cross-sectional area; for control or signal cables, 50% is typical. Ampacity correction factors must be applied for multiple conductors or layered installations. Separation: High-power DC cables must be separated from low-voltage or signal cables to prevent electromagnetic interference (EMI) and maintain safety. Grounding and Bonding: Metallic trays must be properly grounded and can serve as an equipment grounding conductor if compliant with NEC requirements.
