

What voltage is suitable for a distribution box

- Commercial or industrial three-phase: 400–415V (line-to-line), which consists of three 230V lines out of phase by 120 degrees

In some industrial settings, higher voltages such as 480V three-phase may be supplied to the main distribution box to feed heavy machinery. The distribution box then divides this incoming voltage into branch circuits, each protected by circuit breakers, ensuring safe and reliable delivery to lighting, HVAC, and equipment.

Summary The voltage supplied to a distribution box depends on the type of consumer and the system design:

- Homes: 230V single-phase
- Small commercial buildings: 230V single-phase or 400V three-phase
- Large commercial/industrial facilities: 400–480V three-phase

This setup ensures efficient power delivery, safety, and compatibility with electrical devices while allowing the distribution box to manage and protect multiple circuits.
