Power Off: Always turn off the main power supply before starting any wiring to prevent electrocution or short circuits.

Wire Connections:

- Live (L) Wire:** Connect the incoming live wire to the line terminal of the circuit breaker. This serves as the main energy source.
- Neutral (N) Wire:** For single-pole (1P) breakers, connect directly to the neutral busbar. For double-pole (2P) breakers, connect both live and neutral according to markings to ensure simultaneous disconnection.
- Protective Earth (PE) Wire:** Connect to the ground busbar and, if applicable, to breakers with residual current protection (RCDs) to prevent earth faults.

Circuit Protection Devices: Each branch circuit should have its own breaker or fuse. Use 2P breakers for main switches to ensure full isolation, and 1P breakers for simple single-phase loads like lighting.

Terminal Connections: Strip wires to the correct length, insert into terminals, and tighten screws to ensure secure contact. Avoid exposed copper to prevent short circuits.

Grounding: The metal enclosure, electrical installation board, and all metallic components inside the box must be properly grounded. The protective neutral wire should be reliably connected through the terminal board.

Installation and Safety Considerations

- Placement:** Install the box in a dry, ventilated, and accessible area, typically 1.5–1.8 meters above the ground.
- Fixing:** Use firm mounting brackets or screws to prevent movement or tilting due to vibration.
- Cable Management:** Arrange wires neatly, leaving space for heat dissipation. Use cable entry points and DIN rails...
