

Wiring from lighting unit to lamp terminal

- Radial Wiring:** A two-core and earth cable runs from the consumer unit to junction boxes, with separate cables to each light and switch. This method is less common but makes adding new fittings easier.

Connecting the Wires

- Isolate the Power:** Always turn off the circuit at the consumer unit before starting any work.
- Identify Wires:** Mark the live, neutral, and earth wires to avoid confusion.
- Connect to Terminals:**
 - Live wire → switchline terminal
 - Neutral wire → neutral terminal
 - Earth wire → earth terminal
- Secure Connections:** Use terminal blocks or screw terminals to ensure wires are firmly attached.
- Test the Circuit:** After wiring, restore power and test the switch to ensure the lamp operates correctly.
