Circuit breakers, including ACBs, MCCBs, and MCBs, should be installed with proper spacing to ensure arc flash safety and heat dissipation. Wiring Practices Secondary wiring should be neat, horizontal or vertical, and crimped with ferrules before entering terminal blocks. Twisting multi-strand wires directly under screws is prohibited to avoid burrs and short circuits. Busbar connections must be tinned or coated with conductive paste to reduce contact resistance, and bolts should be tightened using a torque wrench to prevent overheating. Current Transformer (CT) secondary circuits must never be open-circuited to avoid high-voltage hazards. Cable routing should allow sufficient space above, below, and between drawers, using cable management arms, raceways, or bridge lances to organize power and communication cables separately. Labeling cables and maintaining a consistent plugging sequence is recommended for maintenance and...
